

INDOOR CAMPFIRE

How to:

Not everyone will be able to make a real campfire in their garden.

If that is the case, then why not make one you can even bring Indoors. It can be big or small.

Kitchen roll tubes can be painted or coloured to look like logs, or you can roll up a magazine or newspaper to give a similar effect. Of course, you can also use logs, sticks and twigs collected on a walk or from your garden.

Make some flames using tissue or coloured paper. Alternatively use felt pens and crayons to colour strips of plain paper.

Did you know that flames are a range of colours including white, blue, orange, red and yellow depending on how hot a real fire is!

Then arrange your logs on a tray, circle of card or something similar and stick the "flames" in the middle of the logs.


Maybe you could arrange some pebbles or twigs around the edge.

Don't forget to put a small torch or battery-operated tea light in the middle so that your fire comes to life when the lights are switched off!









Even if you have an indoor campfire you can still toast marshmallows. There are instructions in the Pre camp pack for Microwave S'mores or if you have a suitable tea light or candle you could ask an adult to light a for you. – but remember to be sensible and careful especially if you are indoors.
