

JAR LANTERN

What you need -	
	Clean glass jar
	Scissors
	Glue
	String or thin wire
	Templates
	Decorations: there are so many things you can use – look to
	see what you have – suggestions include- tissue paper,
	newspaper, paint, wrapping paper, leaves

There are lots of different ways to make lanterns to decorate your campsite - indoors or out.

Make sure you are really careful with tea lights and candles – naked flames must NEVER be taken inside tents or dens and if used indoors should be placed where younger children can't reach them. Lanterns can also be lit up using battery tea lights or even a small torch so there are lots of options to suit everyone!

How to:

- Decorate the outside of your jar if you wish you can draw around some templates, cut out and then stick the shapes onto the jar.
- If you would like your jar to hang, fix string or garden wire around the lip at the top. Make sure an adult checks that it is secure so that it doesn't break and cause your lantern to fall.
- Place a tea light or small candle in the bottom of your jar ready to light during the evening.



SAFETY FIRST



- Fire Make sure you are really careful with tea lights and candles naked flames must NEVER be taken inside tents or dens and should be placed where younger children can't reach them.
- Glass If you are using glass, make sure you place it somewhere secure, where it won't get knocked over.
